You Said...We Did - 2015

Below are details of some of the actions undertaken by the library in 2014/15 based on requests from users and initiatives of the library staff.

Opening Hours

The library will be open until 20:00 on Sundays-Thursdays from the beginning of semester Aleph.

Fulltext Hebrew Journals

We are continuing to expand access to full text articles in Hebrew via the Index to Hebrew Periodicals (IHP). We currently provide full-text access to 47 Hebrew journals via JSTOR.

Additional workstations

We added an extra 14 workstations in the Media/Reserves area.

PC availability software

Software is now available at the Circulation Desk to show patrons where there are available workstations.

Booking system for group study and doctoral rooms

We have extended the duration in the room booking service to a maximum of 4 hours.

Dedicated printer

We have designated one printer for quick printing only in the Central Wing.

Improved signage

We have added new colorful signage in the library and are continuing to do so.

Quiet

We closed the bridge between the southern wing (library offices/study rooms) and the central wing (Media/Reserves) to reduce noise level.

For four hours every day librarians and other staff tour the library making sure that quiet is maintained.

Food and drink in library

We now have designated areas for eating and drinking in addition to the Elite coffee bar.

Cheaper ILL

We now offer free ILL for books and articles ordered from the Technion (for faculty, PhD and MA students).
